Subject: Certificates of Protection for July 1, 2011 – June 30, 2012 and 2011-2012 Memoranda of Coverage

Enclosed is your agency's Certificate of Liability Protection for the 2011-2012 coverage period and, if applicable, your agency's Certificate of Workers' Compensation Protection for the same coverage period.

Also enclosed is the 2011-2012 Memorandum of Liability Coverage and, if applicable, the 2011-2012 Memorandum of Workers' Compensation and Employer's Liability Coverage.

Recent changes, as approved by the Executive Committee at its meeting on June 22, 2011 include changes to dates of coverage in the Memorandum of Workers' Compensation and Employer's Liability Coverage along with a more specific description to the definition of employee (§3.G). Changes to the Memorandum of Liability Coverage are summarized below.

1. Definitions, page 5 – refined definition of "Claim"
2. Definitions, page 10 – refined and clarified definition of "Limited Protected Contract" and provided defined examples for obtaining automatic Evidence of Coverage for certain types of agreements, reserving the right to treat the contract as a Protected Contract if it significantly increases the Member's exposure
3. Definitions, page 11 – refined and clarified definition of "Protected Party" replacing "Occurrences" with "Bodily Injury or Property Damage" and simplified and expanded "Protected Party" status definition as that under a "written agreement"
4. Definitions, page 12 – refined and clarified the definition of "Quiet Zone" by removing verbiage relating to the manner in which wayside horns were approved, constructed and implemented
5. Definitions, page 12 – definition of "Railroad" was added to clarify the exclusion of amusement railroad rides from Exclusion "K"
6. Exclusion K, page 16 – refined and clarified language to ensure that exclusion of railroad related claims does not include exclusion of amusement railroad ride claims as per the definition of "Railroad"
7. Exclusion P, page 17 - addition of verbiage relative to medical marijuana dispensaries to clarify that decisions made to approve or disapprove and efforts to enforce the ordinance(s) relative to these facilities are contained within the exclusion

8. Exclusion Y, page 19 – refined language to clarify the exclusion of front pay if Member is ordered to reinstate a terminated employee

An email was also sent to you and your agency's California JPIA Director, Risk Manager, and Finance Director with an email with a website link to the same documents in electronic format. In addition, coverage summaries for all of the programs available through the California JPIA will be available on the website. The Programs include: Liability, Workers' Compensation, Property, Pollution & Remediation Legal Liability, Crime Coverage, and Special Events.
